Hearing Voices and Paranoia Groups offer people the space to share, and make sense of, their experiences without fear of judgement.

There are over 180 Hearing Voices Groups in the UK, in a range of settings - including charities, user/survivor-led groups, prisons, inpatient units, CAMHS, EIP services, prisons and CMHTs.

This 4 day training course equips you with the knowledge, skills and confidence to set up a new Hearing Voices or Paranoia/Unusual Beliefs Group.

Topics include:

- Understanding voices, visions & 'psychosis'
- Making sense of unusual beliefs/paranoia
- Coping strategies and pathways to recovery
- Rethinking power & empowerment
- Hearing Voices Network ethos
- Planning, launching & establishing safe and effective Hearing Voices Groups
- Practical group facilitation skills

This course is suitable for: anyone intending to facilitate a Hearing Voices or Paranoia Group, whether they have experience gained from personal experience, training and/or profession.
